- Ages (13-19)
- Residence in: Brunswick, Duplin, Edgecombe, Halifax, Hoke, Nash, Onslow, Randolph, Roberson, Scotland, Swain, or Wilson Counties
- Parental Permission is Required for youth under age 18. 18 years & 19 years old's can sign for themselves.
